Please follow the schedule below. Credit completion is at the professional judgement and discretion of the classroom teacher. Teachers will contact students and parents before and/or after exams for those who require credit completion. Students may complete the work in person, at the school, or virtually.

EXAM RULES & PROCEDURES

In preparation for exams this semester, all students must read and understand the following exam rules and procedures:

1. Rooms that have been changed for exams will appear in **Blue**.
2. Grade 12 In-Class Final Exams will be written during class time on June 15 & 16TH and the remainder during the first formal exam dates of June 17 & 18th. Grade 12 students enrolled in grade 11 classes will write their grade 11 exams in the library on grade 12 exam days. Grade 11 students enrolled in a grade 12 course will write their exam on the scheduled grade 12 date and be expected to attend that class until formal exams begin.
3. Formal Exams are from Wednesday, June 17th to Monday, June 22nd, with June 23rd being the inclement weather day. The exam schedule is available on the school website and Students' Google Classrooms.
4. Formal exams from June 17 – 22nd begin at 8:15 am and run for 1.5 or 2.0 hours. Students are responsible for arriving on time with adequate writing supplies.
5. Students arriving late for any exam must report to the office before going to the exam. Students arriving late will be given the remaining time to write the exam in the late room.
6. Exam Attendance - Examinations are clearly marked on the school calendar. If a student is absent for an examination, they must demonstrate that the absence was unavoidable. In the case of illness, a doctor's statement is required stating medically unfit for exams. If necessary, the school will arrange alternate examinations for illness or family tragedy. In the case where the absence is deemed to be invalid, the exam mark shall be zero and incomplete. The report mark shall reflect its impact and the credit jeopardized.
7. If buses are canceled for any reason, exams scheduled for that day will be rescheduled to June 23, 2026.
8. School buses will run on a regular schedule.
9. **At the conclusion of an exam students must leave school property.** The only exception to this rule is students who normally take a school bus. These students must either remain in the cafeteria or leave school property. Students are not to be in the halls while exams are in session.
10. From June 17th to June 22nd, students are only to be on school property when they have a scheduled exam or unless invited by a teacher for credit completion on June 19th (Grade 12s only) and June 24th (Grades 9-11 only).
11. The last day for cafeteria service is Tuesday, June 16th. Food will not be sold during the examination period.
12. The library will not be open during the examination period.

13. Students may not bring to their seat in the examination room, any books, papers, backpacks, electronic devices (including phones, smart watches, non-wired headphones Air Pods, etc.) or other aids unless the use of such material/equipment is authorized by the teacher on the examination paper. If such materials are brought to an exam room, students will be required to leave them at the front of the room. Using/possessing unauthorized material or electronic devices (smartphones, smartwatches, Air Pods, etc.) during an exam may be perceived as cheating.
14. **AI glasses** are considered a personal mobile device and their (digital) use in the classroom is managed the way we would treat cell phones and other mobile devices like smart watches. They must be powered off and not worn during class time or during exams (unless they are the primary vision support, or a school/board approved accommodation for other needs for that student), like smartphones.
15. Students shall not communicate with one another in any manner whatsoever during the examination. Communicating with another student during an exam may be perceived as cheating.
16. If a student is suspected of cheating or assisting someone else to cheat, at the end of the exam, the student and their examination papers will be brought to the office. A mark of zero or other school consequences may be assigned by an administrator.
17. Students may not leave the examination room **unescorted** for any reason, and this includes using the washroom.
18. Students writing 1.5-hour exams must remain in the exam room for the full time of the exam. Students writing a 2-hour exam may only leave after 1.5 hours or stay for the duration of the exam.
19. Wednesday, June 24th, is Credit Completion Day and exam review. Students may come to the school to review their final exam with their teacher from 8:00 am to 10:15 am. Credit completion is at the professional judgment and discretion of the classroom teacher. Teachers will contact students and parents before and/or after exams for those who require credit completion. Students may complete the work in person, at the school, or virtually.
