#### **GRADUATION REMINDERS**

- You need 30 credits to graduate
- 18 COMPULSORY + 12 ELECTIVES
- Of the 30, you will need 2 eLearning Credits \*\*\*
- Pass the OSSLT test this spring (APRIL 4 + 5)
- 40 hours of Community Service
- \*\*\* there is an "opt out" option







#### **ASYNCHRONOUS eLEARNING CLASSES**

#### \*New Requirement\*

- In-person BHS Students will be required to complete 2 Asynchronous eLearning courses to graduate
- It is recommended that you take this in Grade 11
  WANT TO OPT OUT REMEMBER TO FILL IN THE FORM
  - If you like the idea of an online course, you can take up to 2
- Choose STUDYE then choose from the list of eLearning classes in myBlueprint
- For Online Asynchronous courses, you work independently with an Online Teacher, not in real time, and your time table shows "StudyE' OR 'STUDY F". Work in school work spaces or at home.




#### SHSM Programs

## **CHOOSING CLASSES IN MYBLUEPRINT**

- 1. ADD courses to your High School Plan
- 2. **REVIEW** Course Selections
- 3. **SUBMIT** Course Selections
- 4. Click **SEND APPROVAL EMAIL** (put in a valid parent/guardian email address)
- 5. Parent APPROVES courses via email
- 6. Guidance Counsellor APPROVES your selections

## myBlueprint ERRORS

- If you get a **RED** alert: it means there is an **error** in your planner (e.g. no prerequisite) because you chose incorrectly **OR** you are going to take the pre-req in summer school **OR** you are retaking a course that you have already earned the credit
- If you get a **RED** alert because you made an **error**, fix before submitting.
- If you get a **RED** alert for **summer schoo**l, type in the ADD COMMENTS box what course you are going to be taking in summer school (for example: "I will be taking SPH3U1 in summer school" or "I will be upgrading by taking GLC2O1 in the summer")

## SUMMER SCHOOL INFO

## **SUMMER SCHOOL**

You can take summer school if:

- you failed a course and it is offered in summer school (2 weeks)
- you want to upgrade a mark (4 weeks)
- you want to reach ahead (4 weeks)

NEW THIS YEAR: SUMMER SCHOOL registration is

open AT THE SAME TIME AS COURSE SELECTIONS!




All registrations are done through YOUR MyBlueprint account.

## **SUMMER SCHOOL**

To indicate you are planning on taking a course in summer school do the following in myBlueprint:

- 1. Do **NOT select** the course you are wanting/needing to take (e.g. SPH4U1) in myBlueprint planner
- 2. Instead, choose a different course in place of that course in your myBlueprint planner
- 3. When you submit you MUST type a comment in the ADD COMMENTS box telling us WHAT COURSE you are going to be signing yourself up for in Summer School "I am taking SPH4U1 in summer school"
