If a student in a publicly funded school has an Individual Education Plan, the plan should be shared, when appropriate, with an educator instructing an online course delivered by another publicly funded school board, with the necessary consent.

Parents/guardians may choose to opt their child out of the mandatory online courses required for graduation. Students age 18 years of age or older or students who are 16 or 17 years of age and have withdrawn from parental control can also opt out of the graduation requirement. School boards must also allow for students and parents/guardians to opt back into the online learning graduation requirement should their decision change.

#### **TIPS FOR SUCCESS**



Routine – structure is important (homework, sleep, eating...)

Encourage your child to get involved - Direct correlation between happiness and success.

Ask a different question - do better than always asking "how was your day"...force multiple word answers

Encourage them to be self-advocates (guidance counsellor, SERT, classroom teacher, VP)

School FIRST, extras AFTER

Be aware of the school calendar




