Scholarships & Bursaries

Scholarship

- ❖ A scholarship is a sum of money or other aid granted to a student, because of merit (academics, volunteer work, community involvement, athletics etc.)

Bursary

- ❖ A bursary is a monetary award that is granted on the basis of financial need.

Scholarships and bursaries do not need to be paid back

Kinds of Scholarships

ENTRANCE SCHOLARSHIPS

- ❖ Based on final high school grades (starting at 80%)
- ❖ Amounts and requirement vary greatly among schools
- ❖ Do not require an application
- ❖ Check to see if they are renewable

NATIONAL & PRIVATE SCHOLARSHIPS

- ❖ Based on marks (90% or higher) and extracurricular activities
- ❖ Some must be nominated by high school
- ❖ For, Queens, Western & U of T see guidance

General Scholarships

- ❖ All post-secondary schools have other scholarships available
- ❖ Visit the websites for individual schools to see the scholarships they offer

National Scholarships

University of Toronto

The National Scholarship Program

- ❖ Do not need to be nominated by High School to apply to the program
- ❖ Students who demonstrates superior academic performance, original and creative thought, & exceptional achievement in a broad context, demonstrate enthusiasm for intellectual exploration & have a strong involvement in the lives of their schools and communities
- ❖ Multiple items required in the application: i.e.: series of small essays, reference letter, transcript

The National Book Award

- ❖ Require a High School Nomination (1 per high school)
- ❖ Award recipients receive a National Book Award recognizing their achievements
- ❖ It is a non-monetary award (the award is a book)

Queen's University

Major Admission Awards (MAA)

- ❖ Do not need to be nominated by High School to apply to MAA
- ❖ May apply for 1 or all of the Major Admission Awards by submitting a single application – the many awards have their own list of eligibility criteria
- ❖ MANY steps are involved in this process – read Major Admission Award Application webpage

- **Must have applied to Queen's on OUAC by November 20th & created a Queen's SOLUS account min. 7 days before December 8th to be eligible to apply for MAA**

Chancellor's Scholarships (a specific MAA)

- ❖ Require a **High School Nomination** (up to 2 per high school*)
- ❖ 90%+ average
- ❖ Superior academic ability, creative and original thinking, proven leadership qualities

National Scholarships

University of Western Ontario

National Scholarship Program

- ❖ Require a **High School Nomination** (up to 4 per high school)
- ❖ The nominations are for the students to be considered for the scholarships available within the National Scholarship Program
- ❖ Minimum overall academic average of 90% on all Grade 12U/M courses
- ❖ Creative and innovative thought, exceptional achievement in extracurricular activities & commitment to community service through ongoing contributions to school and community life.
- ❖ Must make an admission application (OUAC) to Western University Main Campus to be considered for these scholarships
- ❖ Multiple items required in the application: i.e.: essay, reference letter, transcript

Private Scholarships

Loran Scholars Foundation

Loran Award

- ❖ Do not need to be nominated by High School
- ❖ Students who have demonstrated integrity, courage, grit, personal autonomy, a commitment to serving others & overall leadership potential
- ❖ Be entering university for the 1st time in Sept 2023
- ❖ Minimum cumulative average of 85%
- ❖ There is no limit to the # of applicants from a single high school

Schulich Leader Scholarships

- ❖ Require a **High School Nomination** (1 per high school)
- ❖ Students who demonstrate academic excellence, leadership, charisma, creativity, entrepreneurial-minded, financial need & are pursuing a career in Tech, Engineering, Entrepreneurship/business enterprise or applied scientific research
- ❖ Graduating high school in June 2023
- ❖ Plan to enrol in one of these [eligible STEM programs](#) at a Schulich partner university
