Online Learning Graduation Requirement Opt-Out Form

About the online learning graduation requirement

Students at
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access to the supports they need through their school, (e.g., guidance, tutoring programs, extra-curricular activities and services for English-language learners). If a student in a publicly funded school has an Individual Education Plan, the plan should be shared, when appropriate, with an educator instructing an online course delivered by another publicly funded school board, with the necessary consent.

Parents/guardians may choose to opt their child out of the mandatory online courses required for graduation. Students age 18 years of age or older or students who are 16 or 17 years of age and have withdrawn from parental control can also opt out of the graduation requirement. School boards must also allow for students and parents/guardians to opt back into the online learning graduation requirement should their decision change.

If you would like to opt-out, please read the following and complete the reverse side.

1. Access form from DDSB website:

4. We file the form and change an **indicator** in PowerSchool

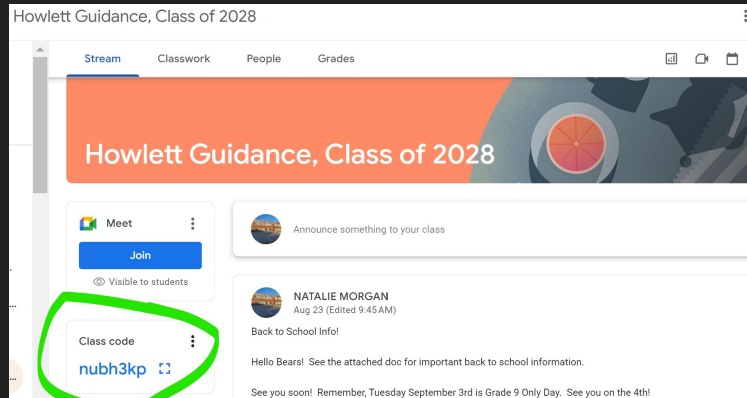

Pathway Planning – Individual Pathway Plan with a focus on **WHO** the child wants to become (not on the **WHAT**)

GUIDANCE

How to change a course?

- Students will make the request using a google form on my google classroom (I will also send out through link on remind), opens **Sept 4th at the end of day**
- Must be logged into DDSB account to access
- Once the form is filled out, I will call them down to guidance
- Space is VERY limited in classes...we are FULL!

TIPS FOR SUCCESS



Routine – structure is important (homework, sleep, eating...)

Encourage your child to get involved – Direct correlation between engagement and happiness + success

Mental Health – encourage mindfulness, resiliency, time for exercise, **the importance of sleep**, **put the technology to bed** (in its own room away from users), check in regularly with your child

TIPS FOR SUCCESS

Communication – website, know your child's subjects & teachers, Guidance Counsellor!

LESS is NOT MORE – now is the time to get/stay involved

Technology – make it your friend – **Parent Portal, twitter, instagram, REMIND, school website**. Model and teach good digital health

Community Involvement – Get it started/done

TIPS FOR SUCCESS

Ask a different question – do better than always asking “how was your day”...force multiple word answers, the more you know the more they will talk

Encourage them to be **self-advocates** (guidance counsellor, SERT, classroom teacher, VP)

School FIRST, extras AFTER

Be aware of the **school calendar**

STUDENT LEADERS AND MENTORS

Grade 12 leadership students that are attached to your child's **homeroom class S1**

Facilitate **sharing of information, mental health tips/strategies, test tips/strategies, community building** in the classroom, **points programs/events**, help with the **transition** from grade 8 to 9

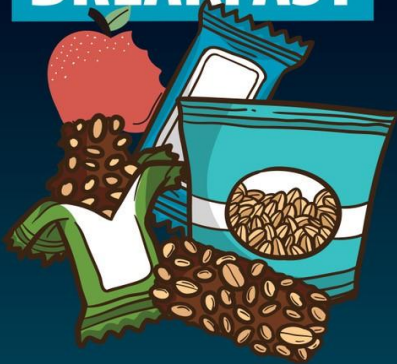

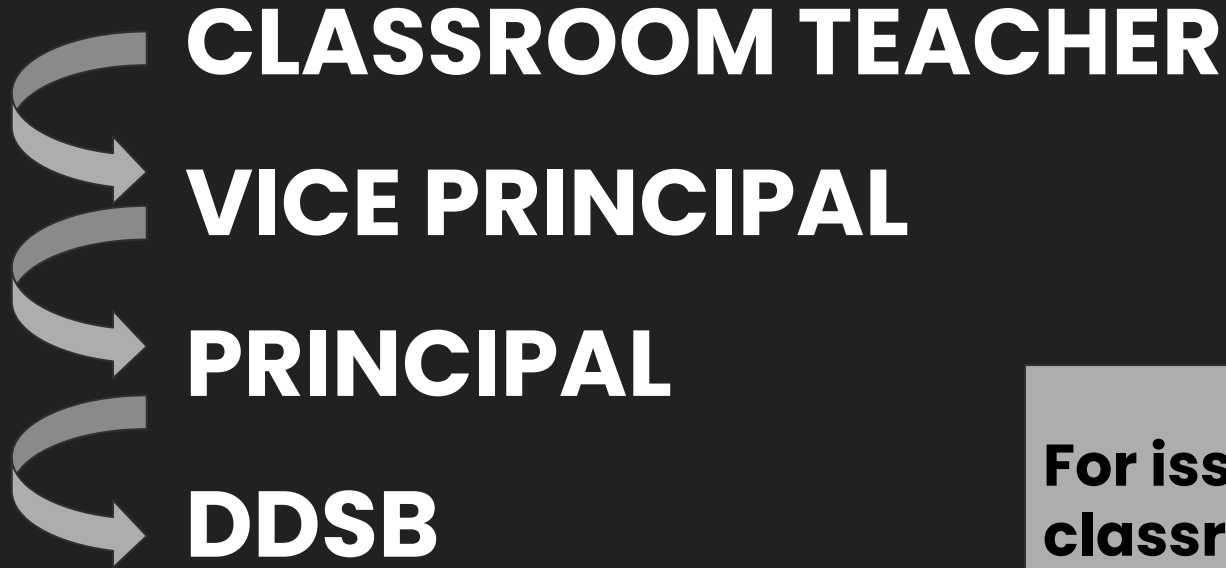
