- a) COVID 19 Protocols
 - i) Students should conduct a self-screening before coming to school
 - ii) Students come to school with masks on and hand sanitizing as they come in the building
 - iii) Staff wear medical masks and potentially, face shields
 - Students encouraged to wash or sanitize their hands; cover their cough and have tightly controlled washroom breaks
 - v) Students and cohorts enter and exit through designated entrances and exits
 - vi) Students are encouraged to maintain social distancing in class and in the hallways
 - vii) The biggest concern is maintaining physical distancing as students leave the school property and congregate. They may remove masks as they walk home. We strongly encourage those students to maintain their social distance as they continue their journey home. If physical distancing becomes a challenge then students are strongly encouraged to wear masks, even outside.
 - viii) Classes are split and there are no more than 15-16 students in a class at a time. *NOTE: Mr. Palmer also reviewed our Quadmester calendar. See here for more information.
 - ix) Realtime & Flextime definitions were reviewed
 - x) OLAS (Online Academic Support) is offered 2:45-4:00PM for every subject area.
 - xi) Enhanced cleaning and disinfection of all touchpoints in classrooms and throughout the school.
 - xii) A Public Health nurse is at Brooklin HS on Fridays and is our Durham Region Public Health contact.

 - Lock Down Practice Thurs. Sept. 24, 2020. All went well and we made accommodations to maintain our physical distancing.
