- November 23(session A) & 25 (session B), 2020 OSSLT (Gr. 11 students) May 2021 OSSLT (Gr. 10 students)
- Practice test Nov. 3rd (for Gr. 11 students)
- Students all have DDSB devices and are required to use them for the OSSLT it is a requirement for registration for the "actual" test.
- Some feedback will be offered on multiple choice, but not for the written section (though a marking rubric is provided).
- *Note the question about the "passing mark" is not able to be provided. EQAO is NOT providing a scheme for pass/fail grade requirements.
- The test is shorter than previous tests notably.
- Unsuccessful gr. 11s will be able to re-write with Gr 10s in the spring. (Admin assumes that Gr. 11 students will likely get their grades be January/February 2021)
- EQAO offers a practice test via their website: LINK

- 6. Report Cards
 - Because universities have changed their dates for grade submissions (from Nove. 18th to Nov. 11th) Q1 mid-terms marks will be submitted to universities. Later, Q2 and Q3 marks will be added.
 - \circ Nov. 15th end of Q1 (Nov. 15th credit recovery day)
 - o Nov. 25th report cards will be available to parents via the parent portal
- 7. Positive School Climate Update
